



Our Lady & St. Oswald's Catholic Primary School Wraparound Care (WAC)

Who can attend the club?

The club is only for the pupils of Our Lady & St. Oswald's Catholic Primary School.

How much does the club cost?

'Wraparound Club (Breakfast) - 7.45-8.40am Monday to Friday is £4 per person including breakfast.

'Wraparound Club (After School) 3.15-5.25pm Monday to Thursday, 3.15-4.15pm on Fridays.

3.15-4.15pm at £4.00

4.15-5.25 pm at £4.50

A snack is included.

How Do I book a place on the WAC?

Starting from September 2025, places at Wraparound Club should be booked via Arbor.

Payment must be made at the time of booking. Those parents who pay using childcare vouchers should speak to the school office on how to pay for their sessions.

We advise that bookings are made in advance as we cannot guarantee that places will be available at short notice. Once we have reached our capacity, the booking system will close. We are unable to accommodate late requests or go over capacity for health and safety reasons.

The deadline for booking a place at breakfast club and after school club is 12pm on the day prior to the session you wish your child to attend. For example: to book for Wednesday 12th booking should be made by 12pm on Tuesday 11th. If your child is not booked into breakfast club or after school club, it will not be possible to admit them.

How far in advance can I book?

You can book and pay for your child's place up to a term in advance.

How do I pay for the WAC Clubs?

Payment must be made at the time of booking via Parent Pay.

Can I use my childcare vouchers to pay for Clubs?

Yes, you just need to contact us to let us know the details of your voucher provider.

If my child wants to attend an after-school enrichment club from 3.15 – 4.15pm, can they still access Wraparound Club from 4.15 – 5.25pm?

Yes, you can book and pay for both separately. Please note though that enrichment clubs have to be booked and paid for a term at a time. Please note enrichment clubs do not run every week of the term. **Children attending Enrichment Club will be given their snack after they have completed the club.** Enrichment clubs e.g. football, are charged at the same rate as after school club (£4).

What happens if my child's enrichment club is cancelled due to bad weather?

Children will automatically be looked after in Cool Club until 4.15pm (unless parents are able to collect earlier). No payment for this will be required as you will already have paid **£4** for the enrichment club.

Can I cancel a booked place at Wraparound Club?

Apologies, but it will not be possible to offer refunds for non-attendance at booked sessions without exceptional reasons which should be discussed with the Head.

Do the clubs have a maximum capacity?

Yes, both Breakfast and afterschool WAC clubs operate at maximum capacity of 30 pupils with two members of staff.

What if my child is poorly and misses their booked WAC Club?

If school is aware of the absence in time to offer your child's place to someone else (at least 48 hours in advance), the fee can be credited for later use. For notifications of less than 48 hours, the fee is non-refundable.

Can I turn up on the morning to see if there are any places?

No. Admittance to breakfast or after school club will not be granted if it has not been booked in advance. We are sorry for any inconvenience this causes, but it is imperative that the health and safety of the children and staff is maintained at all times. In order to do this we must have numbers in advance for planning staffing levels.

Can my child's particular dietary needs be met?

Yes, as long as we are made aware of the needs in advance. If specialist foods are needed, please discuss this with school.

What activities will be available for my child?

We intend to have a range of age appropriate, structured activities that are just for Breakfast Club and Afterschool Club. Children interests will also be catered for. After breakfast the children have access to a range of activities (eg table football , origami, drawing, marble run, construction toys etc) as well as there being help and support with school work or reading.

What will breakfast consist of?

There will be a choice of cereal, i.e. Weetabix, Cornflakes, Cheerios, Rice Krispies, porridge as well as toast, butter and jam or marmalade and a drink (water, milk, fruit juice).

What will afterschool snacks consist of?

Sandwiches with various fillings, cheese and crackers, fruit, cookies and a drink (water or milk).

Who will be in charge of the club?

School teaching assistants and staff employed by the school. School teaching staff will also be on site or contactable if needed.

What if my child is late?

Breakfast will be served until 8.15am, if your child arrives after this time, we may be unable to provide a full breakfast.

What if my child is eligible for Free School Meals or entitled to the Pupil Premium?

Breakfast club and Early Morning Club will be free of charge to all pupils who are entitled to FSM & Pupil Premium. Pupils will also be able to access one free enrichment club afterschool if they wish when the sessions are in operation. These places still must be booked, using the normal booking system.

Is there a discount for siblings?

Sorry, we are unable to offer a discount for siblings because the club running costs are being split equally between the number of places we have available each session and we have ensured costs are kept to a minimum.

What happens if I have paid for Wraparound Club but I am late collecting my child?

If you are late collecting your child, depending on the circumstances, you may be charged the additional £4.50 for the second part of the club, or for every 15 minutes late if you collect later than 5.25pm. If late picking up your child on more than three occasions in an academic year, the school will reserve right to withdraw your use of the provision.
